Net Script

CQ CQ CQ. Welcome to the Amateur Radio Association of Southwest Florida net. This is {**Your Name and Callsign**}, net control station for this evening. This net meets every Wednesday at 1900 local time on 146.67 MHz with a 136.5 PL, or the alternate frequency of 146.64 also with 136.5 PL.

This is an informal, but a directed net. Please follow the directions of the net control station. The purpose of the net is to be informative, and a chance to check the quality of your rig. You may ask questions, and may also post for sale, trade or wants. Most of all it should be fun.

We will begin with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic. Any stations having emergency or priority traffic, please check in now – call signs only please.

PAUSE FOR POSSIBLE CALLS

READ BACK ANY CALLSIGNS

HANDLE THE STATED TRAFFIC

Are there any messages of general interest or bulletins for the net? – Callsigns only please.

PAUSE FOR POSSIBLE CALLS

READ BACK ANY CALLSIGNS

**ANNOUNCE THAT THE TRAFFIC WILL BE HANDLED
AFTER REGULAR CHECKINS**

I will now take regular check-ins for the net. You do not have to be a club member to check-in. Please respond by calling “Net Control” and releasing the push-to-talk switch to see that you are not doubling with another station, then transmit your callsign and name, and announce if you are mobile, portable or short-timer.

PAUSE AND RECORD CHECKINS

READ BACK ALL CALLSIGNS

TAKE ANOTHER STANDBY FOR CALLS

READ BACK ANY ADDITIONAL CALLS

Ask the stations that had traffic to proceed with their traffic

(Traffic/information time)

Ask if there are any questions or comments about the traffic to call the station that had the traffic.

(Traffic/information question time)

Ask if there is any additional traffic for the net. (If not, move on to the rag chew portion.)

Announce Trivia Question

Call stations in order with Mobile, Portable and Short-timers first

(Informal traffic/information time)

After all traffic/information is concluded, ask:

Are there any additional stations wishing to check-in at this time?

If not, read the commercial, as follows.

If you may be interested in joining the Amateur Radio Association of Southwest Florida, go to the club web site www.araswf.org, and click on the next-to-last menu tab at the left marked "Application Form". Download and print the Application Form and send to the ARASWF at the address shown together with the required dues.

If you would like to try your hand at being Net Control for this net, email the club President and download the "Net Script" from the "Files" page on the web site.

Ask for final check-ins

Before we close the net, are there any additional stations wishing to check-in, or any additional comments for the net? If so, please call net control now.

Pause

There is no further business for the net. This is {**Your Name and Callsign**} closing the ARASWF net at {**current time**} and returning the frequency back to regular use. Hope to hear from everyone next week.
